## PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Parishioners,

This past week Mr. Peter Abegg announced that he will not be returning for the next academic year. He has done so in order to explore opportunities in another educational setting closer to his home. While it seems early to make this announcement, it is during this time of the year that Catholic schools seeking a principal begin to interview potential candidates. It is advantageous for Mr. Abegg and Saint Raphael to make this announcement, and to enter into the process early.

Mr. Abegg will remain principal of Saint Raphael the Archangel School until June 30, 2012. There is much work to be done between now and then and Mr. Abegg will be giving the school his complete devotion as he has done for the past two years. During his time with us, Saint Raphael has experienced growth and many changes that have enabled us to better educate your son or daughter.

In the next few weeks, you will be hearing more about the establishment of a Principal Search Committee and interviews will commence in the middle of the month of February. While the faculty is not able to be a part of the individual interviews, I will be seeking their input and guidance. As we move forward, I will do my best to keep you informed of the progress of our search. Saint Raphael the Archangel School has a bright future. Please keep our school in your prayers and most especially that the best possible candidate may be chosen.
