

Dear St. Raphael School Families and Parishioners,

Happy Easter! Christ is risen, He is risen indeed! Please join me in continued prayers for our 2nd Graders and 7th Graders as they prepare for their First Communion and Confirmation, respectively. The students and their teachers have been preparing for these Holy Sacraments for many months, and we will be celebrating these happy occasions very soon. We pray for God's blessings on these St. Raphael students as they travel forward in their Catholic faith journey.

On Holy Thursday our 8th grade class presented a beautiful and moving Living Stations of the Cross for our student body and parishioners. Those who were able to attend all remarked how reverent the students were and how seriously our 8th graders took their roles. Congratulations and thanks to Mrs. Runiewicz and our 8th Grade class for bringing to life for us Jesus' walk to Calvary!

Hopefully you have all heard the good news about the hiring of St. Raphael's next principal, Mrs. Julie Hayes. I am so happy that Mrs. Hayes has accepted the principalship here, and I think you will find her to be knowledgeable and kind. I feel very comfortable handing over the reins to Mrs. Hayes, and I look forward to beginning the transition soon.

Registration for 2017-2018 is looking quite strong for St. Raphael, with 150 students registered for K-8 and 48 students registered for Preschool. We have 25 Kindergarten students registered for next school year and our cap is 28 - so, if you or someone you know is hoping to have a Kindergartener at SRA next school year but has not yet registered, there are only 3 spots remaining! We are projecting total enrollment K-8 at about 170 and Preschool at about 60; these numbers have been very steady for the past 4 years which is very good news for St. Raphael School. That said, even with our projections for enrollment, we will not be at capacity and could make room for a few more students in various grade levels. It's not too late to spread the news to potential families about the academic progress and faith formation happening in our school.
