FR. BOB'S COLUMN

DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAY – Monday, January 16, Holiday

Let us take a moment to reflect on who we honor and why we have a holiday in this country tomorrow. January 15 is the actual birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and is always celebrated on the third Monday of January. Our nation does this to honor the achievements of Dr. King, who was the chief and most effective spokesperson for nonviolent activism in the civil rights movement to end racial segregation in the U.S. in the 1950's and 1960's, until his life was taken by an assassin on April 4, 1968. D

Dr. King was the most influential African American civil rights leader and was instrumental in changing the direction of our country to give full rights to all citizens regardless of the color of their skin, in the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. This landmark legislation outlawed discrimination in public accommodations, facilities, and employment. He helped move things along with the next important law, the Voting Rights Act of 1965, in which it was guaranteed that every American citizen's right to vote would be protected. King was awarded the super-prestigious Nobel Prize for Peace in 1964.

President Reagan first established this holiday in 1983. Dr. King is one of only three people who have a national holiday in the U.S.; the other two are Christopher Columbus and George Washington.

Dr. King was an outstanding Baptist preacher and pastor. As Americans we need to be grateful for the Christian virtues of love of neighbor, courage and perseverance, and hope and faith in God that guided him in his life. We are closer to our American ideals and principles because of Dr. King. Thanks be to God.

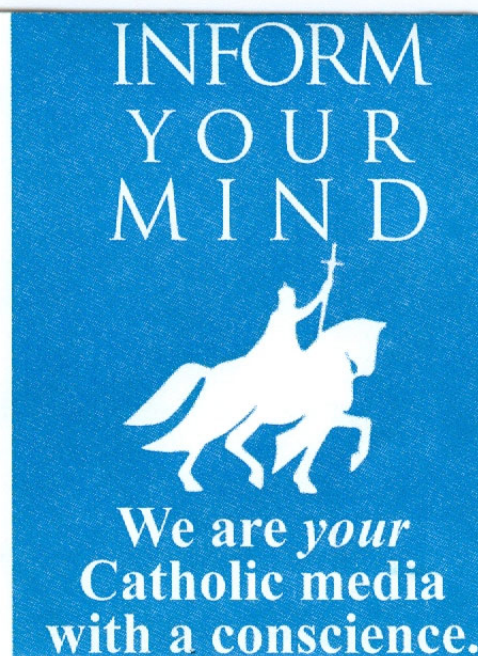
