All of our teachers will be there, there will be lots of student work to view, and we will be giving school tours to prospective new families.

This Open House is our biggest day of marketing during the school each year, and it takes the entire parish and school community to make it successful. **WE NEED YOUR HELP!** These are some of the things you can do to help us show our best selves on this important day:

#### Dear St. Raphael Parishioners,

What an honor it is to be the Music Director at St. Raphael the Archangel Parish! My brother Vince Thomas (d. 2012) was in the first graduating class at St. Raphael's Grade School followed by my sisters Kathy Thomas (Haselhorst) and Barb Thomas (Kohout). Many memories abound as I drive through the community and visit the family home on Blow Street. Learning to play the organ at Mass was something introduced to me by the various School Sisters of Notre Dame that provided music for the Grade School. A disturbing difficulty has confronted the ProLife community in St. Louis. Aldermanic Board Bill 203 would add reproductive health decisions, including abortion, as protected classes, with no exemption for churches or religious organizations. Archbishop Robert Carlson has declared: "There is no room for compromise on such a matter. This is a matter of fundamental religious and moral beliefs."
