

FATHER BOB'S COLUMN

WOW! <u>\$1,000,000</u>! OUR SRA PARISH FAMILY ACHIEVED OUR GOAL FOR THE *"FIFTY & BEYOND"* CAPITAL CAMPAIGN!

Thanks to some anonymous generous gift giving, we finally moved off of the \$973,000 mark where we were stuck for a while, and topped the <u>ONE MILLION DOLLAR</u> mark. Hooray! Hooray!

The "Fifty & Beyond" Capital Campaign by our parish was started last August with its very ambitious goal. Some doubted that we would be able to accomplish this. But YOU did it! From your proud pastor and a grateful SRA Parish Family, a huge word of gratitude for your commitment and generosity to all those members who made a pledge and are generously making their payments for the next several years.

For what purpose, you ask? To review, about half of the money goes to the Archdiocesan "Beyond Sunday" campaign to support Catholic education now and into the future. The other half is to be used for major repairs and maintenance on our 50 year old church. As the cash comes in from your payments, the Archdiocese sends St. Raphael Parish half of the payments to use for the church.

But remember that SRA is also getting 40% of the "Beyond Sunday" portion back to be used for our school major repairs. So already we are replacing the two sets of front doors on the Jamieson side of the school and repairing and painting the entrance and columns by those doors for \$45,000. Then we need to repair and tuckpoint the top of the tall chimney for the school boiler this fall; it is in danger of starting to fall apart. Then we will do some other church improvements. Already we have repaired the wood columns and painted white the whole drive-up entrance of the church. All of this - thanks to your contributions so far to our "Fifty & Beyond" campaign! God bless you!

THIS WEEKEND, SRA HOSTS A VISITING MISSIONARY, FATHER JEAN OSCAR MLANDU, CICM, A MISSIONHURST PRIEST

Each year, usually in the summer, every parish is asked by the Archbishop to host a missionary for one weekend and to allow him to ask for our financial and prayerful support for their particular missionary efforts. This is called the "Missionary Co-op Plan".

This weekend, Father Jean Oscar, CICM, will speak at all the Masses and explain to us the missionary efforts of the Missionhurst religious order which was founded in 1862 for the conversion of China. Today, Missionhurst missionaries serve in some the most remote places such as Mongolia, Indonesia, Africa, Asia, and Latin America. Unlike some emergency relief organizations who come only when needed, Missionhurst priests come prepared to stay, living among the people, sharing in their privations, and participating in the day -to-day effort need to achieve life-long spiritual and material changes. They might start a new farming project, build a new chapel or school, or lay clean water supply lines. Then they seek to "make disciples of all nations" as Jesus has commanded his Church to do.

Please pray about this missionary appeal and be generous today in the special envelope provided in the pews, or bring it back next week with your gift to the Missionhurst missionaries.


2017 - CYC ADULT AND YOUTH SOCCER REFEREES NEEDED

The South Central CYC is in need of Soccer Referees for the upcoming fall soccer season. The requirements for NEW referees for this PAID position are as follows:

- Be 14 years old by August 1, 2017.
- Attend classroom clinic on either Wednesday 7/19 or Sunday 7/30 at Sacred Heart Valley Park from 6 10pm.
- Attend the field training on Saturday 8/5 from 9-11am at St. Gerard Majella.
- Bring cash/check/credit card in the amount of \$30 to purchase referee jersey/pea-less whistle and lanyard/data wallet with pad and red and yellow cards. The jersey is only \$20. Three stripe referee socks will also be available for purchase.
- Receive a score of 92% or above on the 2017 Soccer Official's Test.
- Meet additional archdiocesan requirements if 18 years of age.

RETURNING referees must also receive a score of 92% or above on the 2017 Soccer Official's Test and are encouraged to attend a classroom clinic and on-field training. Classroom clinic is required for returning referees that score <92% on the official's test. Pay ranges from \$15/game for K-2 games to \$30/game for 7th-8th grade games.

Protecting God's Children - Safe Environment Program Compliance

Anyone who works with or volunteers with children must be compliant with the Safe Environment Program of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis set forth by the USCCB. (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) Compliance includes attending a Protecting God's Children Workshop, completing a Worker Registration Form to obtain a background check, and reading and signing a Code of Ethical Conduct. Each location must have copies of individual background checks & code of ethics forms on file for all active volunteers and employees. Additional background checks may be necessary if you have lived out of state in previous years.

To register online for a Protecting God's Children Workshop, please visit <u>www.archstl.org</u> and click on the Protecting God's Children link. You will be redirected to the VIRTUSOnline.org site to complete the registration process. The Code of Ethical Conduct and worker registration forms are available from your parish Child Safety Coordinator and may also be located on your parish website. If you have questions or need assistance with this process please contact the parish office or the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Program at 314-792-7272.

Missouri Background Checks are obtained when you begin your ministry and are updated every even numbered year. Please let the parish office know if you would like to be removed from the list of active volunteers. You must also contact the Missouri Family Care Safety Registry at 1-866-422-6872 with address changes.
