#### FATHER BOB'S COLUMN

#### NOW WE ARE IN "ORDINARY TIME"!

However, there is nothing ordinary about the "Ordinary Time" of the Church Liturgical Year – from June to the end of November – six months until the end of the Church year. Through this "ordinary time," the Liturgy of the Word focuses on the Gospel of Mark and Jesus, who is teaching his disciples (and all of us) how to prepare for the Kingdom of God by following him through his death and resurrection. This is meant to be a season of spiritual growth and harvest as our discipleship matures and produces good fruit.

Because the Gospel of Mark is the shortest of the four gospels, the Cycle B Liturgy of the Word (this year) also includes 5 weeks of readings from the 6th chapter of John's Gospel – the Bread of Life Discourse.

#### WHY DO WE HAVE TO GO TO MASS ... ESPECIALLY DURING THE SUMMER?

Mostly because the Lord lovingly invites us, even commands us, to partake in his special gift of the Holy Eucharist – a celebration of God's Word and Jesus' Body and Blood. Do we dare not accept his invitation – which he is gracious enough to offer us every Sunday of the year – even in summer time? The Lord does not take a vacation from caring for us and loving us. Can we take a vacation from thanking the Lord and celebrating with his people, the Church?

Pope Francis, in his new apostolic exhortation, "Rejoice and Be Glad," teaches us, "Growth in holiness is a journey in community, side by side with others." This community for most of us is our parish family, the worshipping assembly of God's people on Sunday.

Besides your Sunday offertory gift, you can use this site for many other contributions such as Annual Angel Appeal, planned giving, and second collections, school lunches, etc.

- Attend classroom clinic on EITHER <u>Wednesday</u> <u>7/18 OR Sunday 7/29</u> at Sacred Heart – Valley Park from 6-10pm (use gym entrance; session will be held in the Great Hall).
- Attend field training on EITHER <u>Saturday</u> <u>8/1 from 6-7:30pm OR Saturday 8/18</u> from 9-10:30am at Memorial field in Webster Groves (corner of S. Elm and E. Glendale).
- Bring Cash/Check/Credit Card to purchase referee jersey/pea-less whistle and lanyard/data wallet with pad and red and yellow cards. Striped referee socks will also be available for purchase.
- Receive a score of 92% or above on the 2018 Soccer Official's Test.
- Must meet additional archdiocesan requirements if 18 years of age.

Returning referees must also receive a score of 92% or above on the 2018 Soccer Official's Test and are encouraged to attend a classroom clinic and on-field training. Classroom clinic is required for returning referees that score <92% on the official's test.


