

#### **FATHER BOB'S COLUMN**

### SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST ("CORPUS CHRISTI") – TODAY!

The fact that the Church celebrates this day as a "solemnity," not just a feast day, makes good sense, given the Eucharist's centrality in the life of the Church. Holy Communion with the Body and Blood of Christ is the climax of the celebration of Mass. Let's celebrate this mystery of the Real Presence of Christ in the form of bread and wine. This is why we come to celebrate the Eucharist faithfully every week. How can we get by without the presence of Christ in our heart and soul? We cannot is the simple answer. Receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is really too pass up!

At the end of the 10am Mass we begin our annual Corpus Christi procession as a way of renewing our belief in the mysterious presence of Christ in this Blessed Sacrament. We are setting two

outdoor altars – one in front of the gym for people on Jamieson to see and one in front of the rectory for the neighborhood to see. As we process joyfully singing hymns of praise in streets of our community, it allows us to express our gratitude to the Lord for nourishing us with his love through his Body and Blood, and lets the world know that we as Catholics are proud of our Blessed Sacrament – the Holy Eucharist.

#### TODAY IS ALSO FATHER'S DAY – BLESSINGS ON ALL THE FATHERS OF OUR PARISH!

Today we are reminded to be grateful for the gift of fatherhood – that of our own father giving us life, and if we are so privileged, to be a proud father. As your pastor, I take seriously the traditional title of "Father" given to a parish priest. To be your spiritual church father is something I am proud of. To be addressed by you as "Father Bob" is an honor that you bestow on me. (Although in some circumstances, my family and friends just call me "Bob," that is fine too.)

Today we ask the Lord to help and bless all those who are fathers among us. We pray too that children, young or grown, will always love and respect their own father and the men who have been like a father to them, in giving them life, nourishing them, protecting them, guiding them, and loving them.

#### FIRE CHIEF NEIL SVETANICS, 1940-2017

Speaking of fathers, the St. Raphael Parish Family lost a really good father last week, Neil Svetanics, who was buried from St. Raphael Church last Monday. Neil was known for having his priorities right – God, family, and country, but I would have to say that being a fire fighter and the fire chief for the city was right up there in the running. 



#### **ROSARY RECITATION**




