St. Raphael In Puerto Rico

The Reverend Jorge Virella of San Rafael parish in Quebradillas, Puerto Rico, thanked St. Raphael parishioners in St. Louis for their contribution of \$15,000 to repair storm damage from Hurricane Maria that occurred on September 20, 2017. The money was used for the San Jose Chapel, part of San Raphael parish.

One can get an interesting view of San Raphael in Quebradillas by using the web and converting the location map to satellite imagery and raising it to the maximum scale. One can then tour the large town and get a feel for the location. Many of the local businesses, including restaurants and local landmarks, are flagged. The view is mildly amazing, seeing the American franchises and chain stores that are flagged in the town: Pizza Hut, Burger King, Subway, Church's Chicken, the AT&T Store, and a huge Walgreens. Obviously, Quebradillas is very much a part of the United States.

As this issue was being produced, another hurricane passed close by Puerto Rico. Let us pray that San Rafael parish and the rest of Puerto Rico will be spared this hurricane season!
