First you must prepare "If you are hungry, you are my people." Training & support Fair market for milk Proceeds go to an account that both spouses must cosign

COW PROJECT NUTS & BOLTS

- Villagers train together
 - Best farming & homestead practices
 - Hygiene and sanitation
- Village groups form their own rules
- Loan payback = pass on the first heifer to the next family
- Sell extra milk to the dairy for steady income
- BIOGAS
- Clear terms
- 5/600 cows repossessed




