Resuming 8:00am Mass

Tomorrow (Monday) marks the first day that 8:00am Mass will be offered here at St. Raphael in addition to the 7:00am Mass. As in the past, the 8:00am Mass will be celebrated Sunday-Thursday and the 7:00am Mass will be celebrated Monday-Saturday. We will greet our school children to pray at this Mass for the first time on Thursday.

Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary

Speaking of Mass, this week is one of the few remaining Holy Days of Obligation: the Feast of the Assumption. This is the day we remember Mary was taken up to Heaven, body and soul, at the end of her earthly life. Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary as a reminder of the value and dignity of human life. As we gather to celebrate Mary and the great things God has done for her, may we also pray for a growth in the culture of life throughout the world. Mass times are Tuesday, August 14 at 7:00pm and Wednesday, August 15 at 7:00am, 8:00am, and 11:00am with our school children.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

So if you read this announcement last week, you might have been scratching your head about why there were no speakers. I realized I printed the wrong week about half way through 4:30pm Mass last weekend, which was a bit too late to change the bulletin. But I assure you that this weekend, you will hear some of our young people speak after Communion about their desire to restart the Children's Liturgy of the Word here at St. Raphael. This ministry would be offered during the 10:00am Mass from roughly September until May to 3-year olds through 1st grade. They will be invited up to the Sanctuary after the opening prayer to receive a blessing then proceed to the parish office basement to receive the Liturgy of the Word at an age-appropriate level led by teens and adults. They will then come back to church at the offertory and participate in the Mass with the rest of us. This will be a great addition to our parish and I am looking forward to it!

Not Sure I Belong

“and when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, ‘Zacchaeus, make haste and come down; for I must stay at your house today’.” So he made haste and came down, and received him joyfully. And when they saw it they all murmured, “He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner.” Luke 19:5-7

A month after joining the choir, I still feel I do not belong.

Three rehearsals and two services hardly qualify me as a veteran but I should be comfortable by now. The other choir members have welcomed me and several in the congregation have expressed appreciation for my singing. I always get along with people and look forward to a closer fellowship with this group. Yet I am troubled. The problem is me.

Our pastor made a statement from the pulpit that surprised me. “I am convinced that most of you sitting in pews are feeling two things. First, you are saying to yourselves, ‘If these church members really knew me, they wouldn’t like me.’ Second, most of you feel, ‘I’m the only one here who feels this way’.” He continued to talk about the unworthiness most of us feel. Suddenly I realized why I feel so uneasy.

The image disturbs me. People have a way of saying, “He’s a big church member, even sings in the choir.”

Well, I’m no saint. I believe in God and want to serve Him, but if they are looking for a sample of Christ-likeness, they’ll have to look beyond me. In fact, according to our pastor, they’ll have to look beyond the whole church. We’re not here because we’re worthy but because we’re grateful. God accepts us as we are. So I belong here. My unworthiness qualifies me for a group that expresses thanksgiving to the God who welcomes us.

In my search to belong, I feel like Zacchaeus, called out of self-consciousness into God’s community and service. If you sing in a choir, I bet you do, too.

Prayer: Lord, thank you for accepting us when we feel so unacceptable, and thank you for giving us one another.

In Christ, Amen.

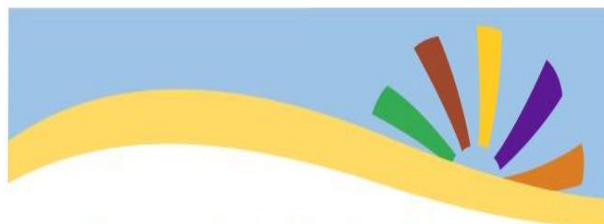

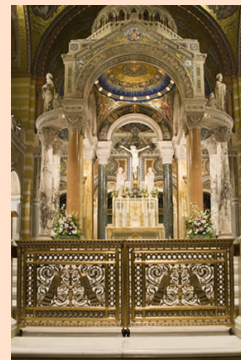
SENIORS HELPING SENIORS
