### **FATHER BOB'S COLUMN**

### READY TO INQUIRE ABOUT BECOMING CATHOLIC? NOW IS THE TIME!

Our St. Raphael program that prepares individuals to join the Catholic Church is soon to begin – on Wednesday, September 13, at 7pm, in the Parish Office lower level meeting room. This is the **R.C.I.A.**, or more fully, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. If you or your spouse (or friend or neighbor) are interested in what is involved in joining the Catholic faith, this is an evening not to be missed. At this time we will explain the nine-month-long process or "rite" for adults to be brought into the Catholic Church. This session is the beginning of the "Inquiry Period" of the R.C.I.A., from September through November. Absolutely no commitment need be made by the inquirer during this time; only at the end of November is the first step taken for becoming Catholic.


