### *Keeping the Spirit of the Season of Advent*

This week, I visited our Kindergarten class. The children are learning about the Season of Advent. They were so proud to perform this song/poem:

Advent is a time to wait, not quite time to celebrate.  
Light the candles one by one, 'til this Advent time is done.  
Christmas Day will soon be here, time for joy and time for cheer

This simple poem calls us back to the most basic truths of Advent. Advent is about waiting and preparing for Jesus' coming. To skip a candle or two to get to the end quicker is tempting. 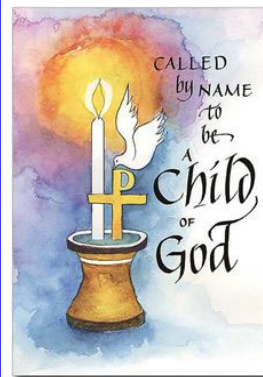

# School News

*From Mrs. Hayes*

This year the calendar afforded us a week to prepare for the Season of Advent. Advent is a time to begin again. Kind of like a fresh start on our faith journey each year. May you be able to take the time to grow stronger in your faith during this Advent Season. Hopefully, you will hear about the many ways we celebrate Advent at school from your child throughout the month. Also, the virtue for the month of December is Generosity - giving without counting the cost. Maybe as a family, you can explore various ways of giving without counting the cost during this Advent. The saints for December are perfect examples of generosity - St. Nicholas, St. Mary Magdalene, and St. Maximilian Kolbe.

*From Mr. Bruno, PE*

During the last few weeks, the students were introduced to field hockey. This was a new sport for a lot of students. The skills involved require eye and hand coordination. Learning to control the stick a certain way was very challenging for most students. They seemed to accept that challenge and grew more confident with each class. With the help of Mrs. Abbott, who played high school and college field hockey, we were able to incorporate the sport into our physical education curriculum. I will continue to stress to all of my students that the main objectives of physical education are to get everyone active, to have fun, and to feel like an important part of the class.

*Miss Molly, Pre-K A*

We have learned about fall and the leaves of fall. We went to the park to hunt leaves for a leaf project. We are starting to learn individual letters. We have started with the letter L. We did a lollipop experiment, played leap frog, made lions, and learned to write the letter L.

*Ms. Domijan, Kindergarten*

During the month of November, the kindergarten class studied pilgrims and Native Americans, turkeys, and wrote what they are thankful for. The class was able to use Miss Domijan's tipi (tepee) during reading. In STREAM, the class went on a leaf hunt and made turkeys out of the leaves they collected. December will be a very busy month with Advent and our gingerbread unit.

*Miss Imo, 5th Grade*

The fifth graders have been studying the Sacrament of the Eucharist. We discussed where the Sacrament comes from and the meaning behind it. We are now going to go through each part of the Mass and discuss in depth why we do and say the things we do during the liturgy. During math, the students began their unit on decimals. They have learned how to read, write, order, and compare them. We are now working on solving problems that include decimals. In literature, the students have been very excited about "Book Club." Each student is expected to read a portion of the book and complete a job that they will share with the rest of the group. The jobs will help the students with asking questions, connecting text, summarizing, finding and learning the meaning of interesting words, and visualizing.

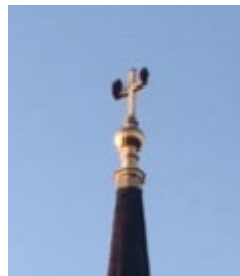
