


LENT - STARTING SOON WITH ASH WEDNESDAY THIS WEEK!

From Ashes To Easter - our annual spring journey through the liturgy of the Church and our own personal Lenten activities are ready to begin. The Cardinals have about six weeks of spring training to get ready for the baseball season; we have about the same amount of time to get ready spiritually for the Easter Season.

This Lenten season of repentance calls us to renew our commitment to love God and to love the community of people around us. This often involves healing human flaws and transforming our relationships

with others. To make it even more challenging, Lent gives us the opportunity to review our relationship with God and with Christ our Lord. As baptized Christians, we use these 40 days of prayer and penance to prepare for renewing our baptismal promises at Easter then we will celebrate the power of God's love for us to give us the new life of grace in the sacraments and eternal life to come.

So...are you ready to start with the ashes of Ash Wednesday and to climax with the water of Baptism at Easter?



The blessing and reception of ashes will take place within the Eucharist. As you come forward for the reception of ashes, let this ritual be a sign of a true commitment to take Lent seriously and to allow the grace of God to truly transform the ashes of your life into the graces of Easter.

Ash Wednesday is a required day of **fasting** and **abstinence**. *Fasting* means having only one full meal and two smaller meals, including nothing between meals. Since there are only two fast days in Lent now (also Good Friday), we probably could do more than this bare minimum. *Abstinence* means refraining from meat. Not only Ash Wednesday, but all Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

After the Second Vatican Council, the Church decided to take a chance and treat us like adults. Therefore, many of the strict rules of fasting were removed and we were challenged as adults to take responsibility on our own to do penance for our sins and to instigate activities that would promote our spiritual growth. This is a lot harder than just following rules.

Make your own personal growth plan for Lent. Three usual categories from Catholic tradition are <u>prayer</u>, <u>fasting</u>, <u>and almsgiving</u>, that is...spiritual activities, physical sacrifices, and acts of generosity. Check out the handout in this bulletin for extra prayer opportunities. Decide to "fast" from something that you do not really need but find it hard to let go of. Take a "rice bowl" home today.

WE STRUGGLE WITH THE UNIMAGINABLE!

As a parish, we must keep praying for the Trokey family of Matt, Mary Jo, and Taylor Rose. So many unanswered questions! We pray for the extended families and for their friends, for the grace to cope with their tragic loss. In addition, we lift up in prayer the neighbors that knew the Trokeys and our own SRA St. Vincent de Paul Society members who worked together so well with Mary Jo in serving the needy of our area. There is definitely an empty spot in church. Lord, help us and strengthen us!

WE ARE FALLING BEHIND - IN SUNDAY COLLECTION TOTALS

For the last five weeks our Sunday offertory collection has averaged only \$7,000 per week, whereas we averaged \$8,000 per week in the six months before. Actually the budget amount needed to match our expenses is \$9,000 per week.

What I am suggesting is that each SRA family look to see if they omitted any Sunday envelopes recently because of missing Mass here at SRA due to winter weather or travel. In order to be financially viable as a parish, we need everyone's cooperation and generosity. We basically do not have a cushion to fall back on.

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK: Yesterday is history, tomorrow is a mystery, today is a gift; unwrap it carefully.


