

FATHER BOB'S COLUMN

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT – TODAY!

Now that we have received the ashes last Wednesday, what's next? One way to look at Lent is to see it as a time of training. Most of us have been watching the Winter Olympics this past week. We cannot help but be impressed with the dedication and extreme amount of training and practice these athletes have put in just to compete and try to win an Olympic gold, silver, or bronze medal. Are we ready to train that hard to receive the prize of eternal life with God and the Communion of Saints?

Lent gives us an intensive 40-day program to re-learn some old skills and learn some new ones. The traditional Lenten practices revolve around Prayer, Fasting (sacrifice), and Almsgiving (charity). New ones could include reading the Bible, sharing some of our time to help the needy, renewing the love we have for family, working for justice in our community, being extra generous to a Lenten project or charity, getting away from our routine for some time out in God's good creation, or participating in one or other of our St. Raphael parish Lenten opportunities. (See the rest of the bulletin or the parish Lenten schedule on-line.) If athletes can do it for a medal, we certainly can do it for God and for his people, even for the salvation of our own souls!

The Rite of Election ritualizes the Catholic community, calling (electing) them to move forward to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. For our SRA four, who have already been baptized, they will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and the Sacrament of the Eucharist for the first time.

All of our St. Raphael Parish Family should warmly encourage them to continue to grow spiritually during the season of Lent, and look forward to celebrating with them at the Easter Vigil.


