# OUR 2018 LENTEN PROJECT – SAN RAFAEL CHURCH IN PUERTO RICO

After some discussion of various options, the parish staff and the Parish Council agreed to help a poor parish in Quebradillas, Puerto Rico, with the same parish patron as we have, replace its roof that was blown off during Hurricane Maria, destroying everything inside with the rain. Until the people get money to replace their roof, they do not have a place to worship and celebrate the Eucharist as a parish family.

In the last two years, our St. Raphael Parish Family has been very successful during Lent in contributing to the Uganda Cow Project and then to the St. Louis Catholic Charities Queen of Peace Center van. Let's keep the tradition going!

Our goal will be \$15,000. So we are arbitrarily dividing that amount into 150 red roof tiles @ \$100 to be placed on our little model of the church. There are special envelopes in the pews this weekend for you to pick how much you can donate to help San Rafael Parish re-roof the church so the people can have Mass again. Return the envelopes next week or sometime during Lent.

# CPR CLASS AT ST. RAPHAEL

St. Raphael's Parish Council has arranged for a Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) class on <u>Saturday</u>, March 10 from 9am



until noon, in the Parish Office's Lower Level. CPR, when performed within moments of a cardiac arrest, may double or triple a person's chance of survival. Most likely, we would be attempting to save the life of someone we love...spouse, parent or friend.

The class is open to SRA parishioners, age 12 and up, and will be held in the Parish Office's Lower Level. The class will include adult and pediatric CPR, along with Automated External Defibrillator (AED) training. The cost is \$35/person and must be paid the morning of training to the CPR instructor. Those successfully completing the training will receive appropriate certification. The CPR instructor will be PCC James Arnold of the St. Louis City Fire Dept. Jim has 33 years of experience in the field of Emergency Medical Services. He is a Paramedic Crew Chief, Training Officer, EMT & Paramedic Instructor. 





# PROLIFE ACTION ALERT

Aldermanic Board Bill 34, the Buffer Zone, was passed out of committee and now goes to the Board for a vote. The first reading was scheduled for Friday, February 16. The Bill would establish an 8-foot Buffer Zone on each side of the driveway into Planned Parenthood. This would effectively prevent ProLifers from passing out literature or having a conversation with the moms entering PP.

The final vote could come as soon as Friday, March 2. Insiders say that the vote will be close. Please contact your alderman - for our ward, it is Thomas Oldenburg. Remind him that you are his constituent and that you oppose BB 34, the Buffer Zone. Contact him more than once a week to indicate your opposition. It is best to make a brief statement.


