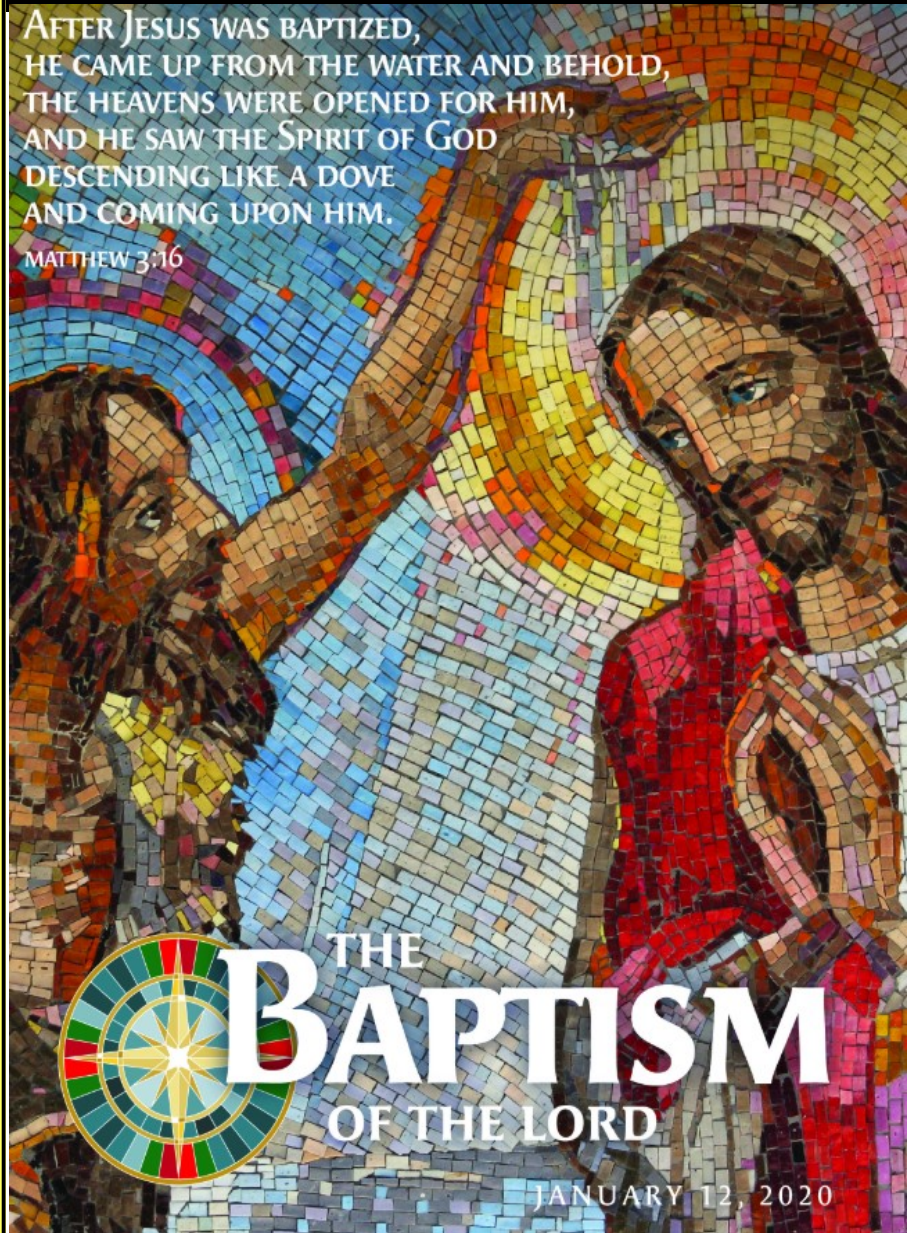

## FR. JOHN'S DIGITAL QUILL FOR SPIRITUAL MUSINGS AND PARISH NEWS

### *Announcing the 2020 SRA Black and Gold Auction Fund-A-Need*

Our Black and Gold Dinner Auction is approaching quickly! On February 8, we will gather for this annual event to benefit our school. It is truly amazing and I hope that everyone will consider attending.

In conversation with Liz and Pat Berry, who are our co-chairs of the dinner auction, and with other parish leadership, we announce that the Fund-A-Need portion of the auction this year will go to benefit the flat roof at the school.

The 50 and Beyond Campaign, as you recall, raised money to benefit projects in the church, including the roof. After my arrival here at St. Raphael, we began to look at the shingled school roof due to leaks there. These investigations revealed that both the school roof and church roof need replacement, with the school roof in worse shape than the church roof. For the last several months since these initial investigations, we have been working to determine the best path forward.

In addition to a shingled roof on the school, there are also portions of flat rubber roofing. These are prominent on the 2000 addition to the school. These rubber roofs, however, are beginning to break down. We believe that the grease and other exhaust from the kitchen is interacting with the rubber, causing deterioration. The warranties on these roofs have expired and, even though they are short of their guaranteed lifespan, they need to be replaced. We look replace them with a material that will be more resistant to the exhaust from the kitchen.

The deterioration on the flat roof and need for replacement of the shingled roof did not cause the flooding over Labor Day weekend. That was caused by a clogged drainage hole on the roof of the school with a large amount of rain in a short period of time. We have begun to address this situation already and will add some additional drainage to the section where the water entered when the roof is replaced. We will take this extra step as there appears to have been some minor water damage in this same area from past backups.

Funds from the 50 and Beyond Campaign continue to be earmarked for replacement of the church roof and other projects inside the church as well. While roofs are important, fulfilling our commitments, made in the 50 and Beyond Campaign, remains the governing interest in the use of these funds. It would be a mistake to take any funds from this campaign to pay for additional projects outside of the original ones. Taking additional funds would jeopardize our ability to complete the other campaign projects.

A successful Fund-A-Need to replace the flat roofing on the school is a good way for us to fulfill this pressing capital need. I ask that you prayerfully consider contributing to this Fund-A-Need project for our school.

### *From the Hip-Hip and Hooray Department*

Thank you to our scouts for serving those in need at St. Vincent de Paul over Christmas break. A special thanks goes to Brian Smith and John Molina for preparing the food with the grade 8 Boy Scouts.

We also commend our young men for conducting themselves well. In the words of their Scoutmaster, Tom Finan,

The manager of the dinner pulled me aside and said that he was extremely impressed with our young men. He said they all followed directions well (a scout is obedient), they smiled and created a great atmosphere (a scout is cheerful), they were very polite (a scout is courteous), and they cleaned up the hall really well (a scout is clean). Again, I could not be more proud of our guys.

### *Eucharistic Adoration*

Please continue to check the schedule in the Jamieson vestibule and sign up for a time to be with the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. We do welcome people who drop-in and spend some time in prayer, but we need someone with the Lord the whole time of Adoration. If you need the code to enter the parish office for Adoration, please contact the parish staff or me.

### *School Open House*

I invite you to be an ambassador for our school by talking up our open house on Sunday, January 26. It will extend from 11:00am to 3:00pm. We invite everyone to come by, especially those who will have students eligible to enter Pre-K through 8th grade. Hope to see you there!

We will also have times to do some detail cleaning of our school to put our best foot forward for our open house. Please join us for some cleaning on Saturday, January 18 and 25, beginning at 9:00am each day.
