Andrea was attacked in her home as she slept. Arriving on the scene, the paramedics found no pulse at first, but Andrea fought to survive. She had suffered a traumatic brain injury. A decade after the attack, Andrea still feels unsafe when alone. She joined a Catholic Charities' Call Reassurance Program. A volunteer calls her once a week to remind her that she is loved and that she needs to take her medicine. Andrea feels blessed now. She says she wants to give to others as others have given to her. 

PROLIFE MONTH ENDS

Two significant events carried us to the end of the ProLife month of January: the Roe v. Wade Memorial Mass and the March for Life in Washington, DC. On January 21, at the Cathedral Basilica, the ProLife community commemorated the Roe v. Wade decision with its annual Memorial Mass and Rose procession. Archbishop Carlson crafted his homily around Aldermanic Board Bill 203, which would hamper our efforts to oppose the horror of abortion. He spoke against the Bill in powerful and persuasive terms, condemning it as an attempt to establish St. Louis as a "sanctuary city for abortion." After Mass, the participants processed to the Planned Parenthood facility, praying the Rosary as they walked. On January 25, our Eighth Graders and their chaperones traveled to Washington, DC to participate in the annual March for Life. We thank our students for undertaking the long journey and for representing the SRA community at the March. We thank them for standing for Life (literally) against the Culture of Death. May the Lord bless us all as we strive to build the Culture of Life.
