# FR. JOHN'S DIGITAL QUILL FOR SPIRITUAL MUSINGS AND PARISH NEWS

Epiphany Chalk

This Sunday, at Mass we will bless the chalk for the Feast Day of Epiphany. This blessed chalk extends a blessing to our homes. When we write the formula of the Epiphany above the main door of our homes, we are asking God's blessings.

The formula for this year is 20+C+M+B+20.

The 20 at either end represents the year we are in, 2020. The letters C, M, and B stand for two things. They first represent the traditional names of the wise men: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Just as these wise men journeyed many miles to visit Christ, we ask God that, as we and our family and friends pass through our doors, they may find Christ there and take Him with them as well. CMB also stands for the Latin phrase *Christus Mansionem Benedicat*: "May Christ bless the house."

After the chalk is blessed during Mass, we invite you to take a plastic bag from its place by the doors of the church. Inside, you will find an instruction sheet and a piece of chalk. Use the chalk to write the blessing above the main door of your home on the inside door trim and say the prayer on the sheet. If your children would like the blessing written above their door, you may do that as well.

The blessing remains there throughout the year as a reminder of the Feast of the Epiphany, of having Christ in our homes, receiving Him in our guests, and taking Him with us on our journeys.

# **Eucharistic Adoration**

This week marks a great new beginning for our parish community. We offer a weekly time for Eucharistic Adoration! The blessing of being with the Lord in silence that we experience on the First Friday of each month and during the Season of Advent will extend throughout the year.

Eucharistic Adoration will be held in our Adoration Chapel in the rectory on Wednesdays from 3:00-10:00pm. Our time of Adoration on the First Friday of each month from 7:30am-2:15pm will also continue to be offered in church.

In order to continue to offer this blessing to our parish, we need your help! Someone needs to be with Our Lord when He is exposed in the Monstrance. Thus, we will continue to offer signup times to be with the Lord.

Each month, we will have post a list where people can opt for times to be with the Lord. The slots are a half-hour long. We invite you to sign up for one or two slots (half-an-hour or an hour) each week or as often as you can.

I am excited to offer this opportunity to be with the Lord each week, and I pray that many people will work some time with the Lord into their schedules on a regular basis.


