

The South Central CYC is in need of soccer referees for the upcoming fall soccer season. The requirements for NEW referees for this PAID position are as follows:

- Must be 14 years old by August 1, 2018.
- Attend classroom clinic on <u>Sunday 7/29</u> at Sacred Heart – Valley Park from 6-10pm (use gym entrance; session will be held in the Great Hall).
- Attend field training on EITHER <u>Wednesday</u> <u>8/1 from 6-7:30pm OR Saturday 8/18</u> from 9-10:30am at Memorial field in Webster Groves (corner of S. Elm and E. Glendale).
- Bring Cash/Check/Credit Card to purchase referee jersey/pea-less whistle and lanyard/data wallet with pad and red and yellow cards.
 Striped referee socks will also be available for purchase.
- Receive a score of 92% or above on the 2018 Soccer Official's Test.
- Must meet additional archdiocesan requirements if 18 years of age.

Returning referees must also receive a score of 92% or above on the 2018 Soccer Official's Test and are encouraged to attend a classroom clinic and on-field training. Classroom clinic is required for returning referees that score <92% on the official's test.

Dear Friends in Christ,

In the Archdiocese of St. Louis, an important agency dedicated to the mission of the church and our call to evangelization is our own Latin America Apostolate. Since 1956, we have sent over 45 archdiocesan priests to serve the people of Bolivia, one of the poorest countries in South America. This year, we offer praise and thanks to our Lord, as Fr. Patrick Hayden and Fr. James Michler both celebrate 25 years of missionary service to the apostolate. Their perseverance and endurance in an archdiocese where there is only one priest for every twenty-thousand Catholics is an outstanding testimony to their faith and to the support and encouragement they receive through the faithful of our local archdiocese.

As Pope Francis reminds us, "the drive to go forth and give, to go out from ourselves, to keep pressing forward in our sowing of the good seed, remains ever present", and so our mission continues (EG 21). He goes on to say that, "new evangelization calls for personal involvement on the part of each of the baptized. Every Christian is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization" (EG 120). While we are all called to be missionary disciples to our friends, family, and neighbors, we are also called to evangelize to all the ends of the earth. Although many of us do not serve in the mission field, we can and should support those who are evangelizing to the marginalized and forming missionary disciples in global communities, including our priests in La Paz, Bolivia.

Without the prayers and sacrifices of the people of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, our Latin America Apostolate could not offer formation, catechesis, social services, and pastoral care to the parish community of Maria Reina. Ask God how He is calling you to participate in this mission financially. Please pray for our Latin America Apostolate, missionaries, and all involved with this ministry. Doing What I Can

"...to one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away." Matthew 25:15

"We need catechists for our Parish Religious Education," the Pastor announced. "God calls you into service."

My kids are in the PRE program, but I have no talent for teaching. Ted sings in the choir and he also teaches an adult class. He is one of those five-talent guys. I have one talent. I can sing.

God did not create us all equal. Some, for no apparent reason, get five talents; others four, and most of us only one or two. The person with five has the edge, for the gap between many and lesser talents continues to widen. That's the way life is.

No wonder many one-talented people grow cynical. The deck is stacked against them, they complain, but that's no excuse. They can either shut down in self-pity or they can use the one talent they have for God's glory.

I don't teach but I can do my share. All members of the choir can't sing solos but we each have a part to carry. I can't be anyone else and I'd look like a fool to try. God expects me to do the best I can with my limited talent. I have only one but I'm learning to appreciate it. The excitement of belonging to the one-talent army comes from knowing that foot soldiers, not generals, win battles. The church depends upon the masses of one-talented lay people, each carrying a bit of the load. The miracle of a choir augments the tones of mediocre voices into the harmony of a symphony.

Few of us possess unusual talents. God simply calls each of us to use what He gives us in service to Him.
