

FATHER BOB'S COLUMN

FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY – TODAY

To quote the Gethsemane Lutheran Church marquee sign, "The Holy Trinity does not mean: me, myself, and I." Obviously we are celebrating that God has been revealed to us by Jesus as a trinity of persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Three distinct persons in one single reality that we call – God!

Have you ever noticed how often we invoke the divine persons of the Trinity in our liturgical prayers and in our personal prayers? With a prayer we call the Sign of the Cross, we so often invoke the three divine persons: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." Usually in the Mass prayers, we call upon the Father, as we pray through the Son, and with the Holy Spirit. Try to identify this dynamic of the persons of the Trinity in our liturgical prayers. Then just notice how you address God in your personal prayers.

This personal relationship with the Three Persons of the Trinity started for each of us as we were baptized into the Trinity. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, especially with holy water as we enter church, we are reminding ourselves of our tri-fold connection to God that started at our Baptism.

Indeed, the Holy Trinity is a sacred mystery. On the other hand, how each of the three divine persons relates to us is not so mysterious. *Praise be to God, the Most Holy Trinity - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit!*

TODAY, SUNDAY, JUNE 11th, IS "FELLOWSHIP SUNDAY"!

That is the new code word for "<u>Doughnuts and good fellowship with friends</u>," in the cafeteria after the 8am and the 10am Masses. Come, y'all!

NEXT SUNDAY IS FATHER'S DAY AND FAMILY SUNDAY!

This is the perfect Sunday for Family Sunday. All fathers in our SRA Parish Family, make sure you show your strength as a good father and bring the WHOLE FAMILY to the Family Mass at 10am.

NEXT SUNDAY – THE FEAST OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

For everybody, but especially for our traditional Catholics, show your devotion to the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist by participating in our annual Corpus Christi procession with the Blessed Sacrament displayed in the monstrance. At the end of the 10am Mass, we will all process up the sidewalk with a hymn of praise to the front steps of the gym. There we will have benediction (a special sacred blessing with the Blessed Sacrament) at the temporary altar. Then we will form a procession again to the front of the Rectory and another benediction. We will conclude with a procession back into the church for a final benediction.

By participating in good numbers, we are making a statement to the world that we at St. Raphael Parish believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist!

SUMMER VACATION - A TIME FOR REST AND RELAXATION

Remember that God's love for us never takes a vacation, and so our desire to lovingly thank God through our participation at Sunday Mass should also never take a vacation. Being at the lake, being at grandma's, being out of town does not preclude our need to still thank God every Sunday for all his blessings. Besides, the Lord Jesus wants to share himself with us in Holy Communion every Sunday of the year, even in the summer time; do not disappoint the Lord.

I guess as pastor I feel compelled to say this too: SRA parish bills do not take a vacation. All of our parish and school salaries are paid for 12 months, and the same with utilities. Please make sure that your Sunday offering does not take a vacation either!




