## Fr. John's Digital Quill for Spiritual Musings and Parish News

### 50 and Beyond Campaign Update

Since I arrived nearly a year ago here at St. Raphael the Archangel, I have taken time to study the capital campaign. As part of the 50 and Beyond Campaign, St. Raphael the Archangel made a commitment to replace the roof of the church and cited a cost of \$150,000 for this expense.

As our Maintenance Committee has begun to meet and examine our facilities, we noticed that the shingled roof on the pitched areas were in poor condition. Several contractors that have looked at the church and school roofs have noticed the school roof is in more critical condition and needs immediate attention.

This need does make sense. When Msgr. William Drennan was pastor, he replaced the roof on the school and the church at about the same time. It makes sense, then, that both roofs would now be due for replacement.

After receiving bids, we believe that we can replace the roof on the church and the school for about \$150,000. We may need to look for ways to fund replacement of the roof on the rectory and minorly supplement the church, but we believe this is all doable. We also know that the school roof is at a state that waiting for replacement is not an option without risking water damage to the school. The roof on the church has been given at least 2-3 more years of life, depending on which contractor you speak with.

I am thus writing and announcing my intention to use part of the 50 and Beyond Campaign funds that were designated for the church roof for the replacement of the shingled sections of the school roof this summer. After this project is paid for, we will look to next spring or summer to replace the roof on the church and then to proceed with any needed plaster repairs and repainting of the church.

Since this project was not part of the original campaign, you may elect not to have your monies used for this project. If this is your intention, please call the parish office so that we may set your funds aside for the projects on the church that will take place after the school roof project.

### School Flat Roof

Separate from this need on the shingled roof of the school, the flat roof of the school is in good shape, except for one area where some repairs are needed. This will also be taken care of this summer as well with parish fund/building fund monies.

### Importance of 50 and Beyond

Thank you for your continued support of the 50 and Beyond Campaign. In June, we will receive \$28,912.65 from fulfilled pledges to the campaign. Thank you!

I know that we have had many needs here at St. Raphael the Archangel in terms of operational needs, so the 50 and Beyond projects seem to be put on the back burner more often than not. Please know that we do want to complete these projects, but need families to continue to pay on their pledges in order to complete the projects we set out to do in this campaign. We have fulfilled our payments to Beyond Sunday, so 100% of your pledges come right here to SRA and are set aside to fulfill the 50 and Beyond projects as we have the funds on hand and they fit into the logical progression of the campaign.

### Enthronement of the Sacred Heart

The ceremony last week was beautiful and I believe that many graces will flow into the life of our parish and into our families from this enthronement. Please take a prayer card at one of the doors of the church and consider praying it once a week or so, asking the Lord to continue to pour His graces into our parish and all of our families.

Please, then, do not be afraid to come, thinking that you may be stuck with a commitment you really do not want. We need ideas and people to run them and the Holy Spirit will direct the ideas and people to run them if they are not one in the same!




