

Fr. John's Digital Quill for Spiritual Musings and Parish News

Rejoice and Repent...For Here Comes Lent!

This week, we will begin our annual spiritual practice of the Season of Lent. Popularly, we may see Lent as that season where we are supposed to give something up that we like for 40 days. The reason that we give something up is not to make ourselves suffer. We are not sadists who seek out suffering for the sake of suffering. Instead, when we give something up that we like, we create room in our life for something new to take its place. Ideally, in Lent, this should be something of the Lord.

So for instance, perhaps I enjoy a piece of chocolate at the end of the day. In and of itself, there is nothing wrong with enjoying a little treat. But perhaps during Lent, instead of enjoying this piece of chocolate, I refrain from the chocolate and spend those couple of minutes reviewing my day, not with chocolate, but with the Lord. I ask Him for guidance and forgiveness as well as thank Him for the blessings that have come to me during the day.

This small act of penance has become an opportunity to grow closer to the Lord. By having this additional time with the Lord in my life, I pray that Easter will be a much more joyful and important celebration this year.

What are you doing for Lent? How will it help you to get closer to the Lord?

Ash Wednesday Schedule

We will celebrate Mass and distribute ashes on Ash Wednesday at 7:00am, 8:00am, and 7:00pm.

Regulations for Lent

The USCCB has provided the regulations that all Catholics in the United States will commonly practice this Lenten Season:
Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the fasting norms are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onward.

Lenten Project

This weekend, we will hear more about our Lenten project for this year. We will be focusing on how we can serve one another more fully this Lenten Season. Please take some time as Lent begins to examine the mailing you have or should receive very soon and pray about how the Lord may be calling you to serve Him in our parish this Lent and beyond.

How We Will Spend Our Lent

In the mailing that will go home, you will find information on the liturgies of the Lenten Season.

Our spiritual focus this Lent will be the basic Catholic devotions. On Tuesdays, we will have confessions available from 6:15-6:45pm. Holy Mass will follow at 7:00pm with a 27.5 minute guarantee! Following Mass, we will have a short presentation and practice of a traditional Catholic devotion. This will all conclude by 8:00pm. If you are looking for something a bit spiritual in Lent, this is the perfect event for you. Also, if you miss one week, you can keep coming, as each week we will cover a new devotion that is separate from the previous week.

Other spiritual activities this Lent are celebrating the Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 2:00pm (and on March 15 at 7:00pm as well), a communal celebration of the Anointing of the Sick, and extra times for confession.

Please consider taking some extra time to add a faith component to our time of fellowship.




