PROLIFE ACTION ALERT!

The 2017 session of the MO General Assembly ended on Friday, May 12. The MO Senate still needed to pass 2 important ProLife bills to stop the creation of abortion sanctuaries and to stop the selling or donating of fetal remains. The Senate bills were SB 41 and SB 67. The Senate had to take action to pass these bills since the House had already passed its versions of the same bills. As of this publication date, the result of the voting is unknown.
