

We are pleased to present now to the parish this document which explains the purpose and responsibilities of the parish council and how we intend to select new members for the council beginning this year. We need your help in selecting these members. If you or someone you know is interested in serving on the council, we invite you to complete the nomination form at the end of the document and return it to the parish office or put it in the Sunday offertory. Nominations are anonymous; no one will know that you nominated them to serve on the council.

St. Raphael the Archangel Parish Council

Purpose

Provides counsel to Pastor and leadership to the Parish on discerned topics and initiatives; seeks counsel from other groups in the Parish as necessary

Responsibilities of Council members

Participate in scheduled Council meetings; advise when not able to attend

Support the shared vision for the Parish Assist in completing the priorities for the Parish Listen to comments and concerns of parishioners and effectively communicate them to the Council and pastoral leadership

Commit, when possible, to attend Parish events Respect confidentiality of Council and Pastor

Meetings

Executive committee of Pastor, President, Vice-President, and Secretary meet as needed to set agenda.

Parish Council meets monthly; other meetings/retreats as scheduled.

Membership

Consists of 9 members and 2 alternates.

An alternate member is asked to come on the Council during the Council year if one of the members asks to step down from the Parish Council; the alternate assumes the rest of the member's term. At the discretion of the Parish Council and Pastor, the alternate may not need to go through the discernment process to become a full Council member. Members have three year terms staggered.

Process of Membership

Nomination process

There will be bulletin notice and Mass announcements for two weeks to prayerfully consider themselves and/or to ask individuals if they would consider being part of the Parish Council.

Beginning the second week and one week after, nomination forms are placed in the bulletin, due by the following Sunday to the Pastor.

Parish Council members are asked to contact candidates and invite them to be part of the discernment process.

Discernment process

This process takes place in two separate evening meetings. The first one should be scheduled a week to ten days after nominations are to be handed in, with the second one a week later.

Candidates should attend both meetings. If there is an unavoidable conflict or emergency situation that occurs at the same time as one of the meetings, the candidate should contact the Pastor. Candidates who cannot attend either meeting cannot be part of the current discernment process and should be encouraged to consider nominating themselves for the following year.

Meeting #1 Information night

The purpose of this meeting is to allow the candidates to get to know the existing Parish Council, to hear expectations of being on the Council, and to discern if God is calling them to be on the Council. The meeting begins with an introduction from the Pastor with prayer, thanking the candidates for coming, and describing his vision for Parish Council more fully.

The President (or Vice-President) then explains more about what it means to be on Parish Council. Parish Council members who are present are invited to give witness to their experience and thoughts on being on the Council.

Time is given to allow candidates to ask questions about being on the Council. These are fielded by the Council President or the Pastor.

The Pastor gives out a sheet for the candidates to prayerfully complete, talking about who they are, the gifts they bring to the Council, and if they discern an openness to be part of Parish Council. If the candidate chooses not to further pursue the Council position, he or she may contact the Pastor and name will be pulled.

Meeting #2 Discernment Night

The purpose of this meeting is to enter into a prayerful environment to hear about the gifts and talents of the prospective members of the Parish Council and to witness the action of the Holy Spirit in choosing new Parish Council members to guide our Parish.

The Pastor is charged with developing and presiding over an appropriate prayer service to open the evening, focused on service and the Holy Spirit. In the context of the prayer service, each member and candidate present is invited to share the fruits of their prayer from the past week, especially about who they are, what gifts and fruits they bring to the Council, and if they discern an openness to serve on the Council.

After the time of sharing:

If there are three or fewer people who discern they feel called to be part of the Council, they are added to the Council. If there are between four to five people who discern they feel called to be part of the Council, they should be asked if any of them feel called to serve as alternates. Consensus should first be reached on who is willing to serve as alternates and Council members. If a consensus cannot be reached, the decision can be made by picking names out of a hat. (Alternate members do not attend routinely scheduled Council meetings.)

If there are more than five candidates discerning a desire to come onto the Council, a brief time of discussion and consensus may occur. If no consensus can be reached within a reasonable amount of time, the decision can be made by picking names out of a hat.

The prayer service concludes, thanking all for being part of the discernment process and also giving thanks to God for giving our Parish new leadership.

Election of Officers

At the first Council meeting after the discernment process and new members are present, the Council is to select a president, vice-president, and secretary, by either acclimation, consensus, or voting. It is preferred that the president and vice-president come from tenured Council members.
