

### **PROLIFE ACTION ALERT**

Sadly, none of the ProLife legislation up for passage in the Missouri Legislature was enacted into law. These proposed laws failed to achieve passage as the legislators ended their session on May 12:

- Abortion Sanctuary Cities HB 174 and SB 41 would have prohibited cities from adding reproductive rights to anti-discrimination ordinances, as St. Louis did in February
- Ban on Abortions would have prohibited abortions after 20 weeks of pregnancy
- Fetal Tissue SB 67 would have banned the donation of fetal tissue for medical research and would have required annual on-site inspections of abortion clinics

Obviously, we will have to pray and work harder so that these bills can be re-introduced and then passed in the next legislative session. Thank you for Standing up for Life. The St. Raphael ProLife Committee
