

#### **FATHER BOB'S COLUMN**

#### OCTOBER - PRO-LIFE MONTH

It has been 43 years since abortion was made legal in our country, due to the decision of the U.S. Supreme Court in 1973. In response to abortion-on-demand as a national policy, there has always persisted a



network of scholars, activists, protesters, writers, and millions of citizens dedicated to one overwhelming idea – the inherent dignity of the human person. The crusade among many religious people, not just Catholics, goes on, emphasizing the God-given right to life of all human beings – from conception to natural death.

Who would disagree that human life is a gift from God and every human being has a right to life and a right to life with dignity? But with the constant repetition of the messages from powerful groups in our society today that promote the "culture of death," Catholic teaching and that of many Christian churches can begin to seem out of step and out of date, even to some Catholics. However, as believers in a God who is revealed to us as the creator of human life, we in our consciences understand that human life in all its forms is a gift from God that must be protected and valued. We are hopeful that the "culture of death" is destined to be pushed aside by the "culture of life" that is so intuitively correct, even to unbelievers. Life is too sacred to not be protected by society itself and the laws that govern it.

Pro-life efforts and the apostolate of life have turned many hearts toward reverence and awe for the mystery of human life. Each of us is given

opportunities to change the minds and hearts of those close to us. Let us not be afraid to speak up to family and friends about the sanctity of human life from its tiniest beginning in the womb to the final moments at the end of natural life. Lord, have mercy! Jesus, help us! Holy Spirit, guide us!




