

FATHER BOB'S COLUMN

STEWARDSHIP: BEING GRATEFUL AND GENEROUS

This week St. Raphael the Archangel Parish is beginning a "<u>Stewardship Awareness Campaign</u>," along with other parishes of the Archdiocese. This is an effort to have all of us understand more fully that Stewardship is an invitation to live with joy and gratitude for the blessings you have received.

This Sunday, our Finance Council will present the Annual Parish Stewardship Report. The following Sunday is Stewardship Awareness Sunday, followed by a weekend with a lay witness talk at each Mass. This includes our Parish Feast Day celebration on Saturday, Sept. 30, at 4:30 Mass, followed by a dinner for all members afterwards. Then we have Stewardship Covenant Sunday on October 15. So you can see that this is an important time for St. Raphael members to be present for Mass here on these Sundays (or Saturday evenings).

Twenty-five years ago, the American bishops wrote a significant pastoral letter on Stewardship for Catholics in the United States. They taught that Stewardship is an expression of our discipleship as Christians following Jesus Christ in a way of life that acknowledges that God is the source of all that we have and all that we are. This leads to gratitude and generosity out of love of God and others. We will be reflecting more on living this virtue of good stewardship as a Catholic in our real world.



CARDINALS NIGHT WITH SRA LADIES' CLUB



A Distinctive Vision? Catholic Higher Education

50 Years after Land O'Lakes

Saint Louis University and the Association of Catholic Colleges and Universities announce an interdisciplinary symposium on Catholic higher education fifty years after the Land O'Lakes statement on the nature of the Catholic university - a watershed moment in contemporary American Catholic history. In July 1967, a group of Catholic educators, administrators, and board members gathered in Land O'Lakes, Wisconsin to "study the nature and role of the contemporary Catholic university" in the wake of the Second Vatican Council. While certainly influential, the statement has not gone uncontested. Some consider it a revolutionary roadmap for Catholic education in the modern world; others have declared a half-century of devastation. Still others designate it a mixed legacy.
