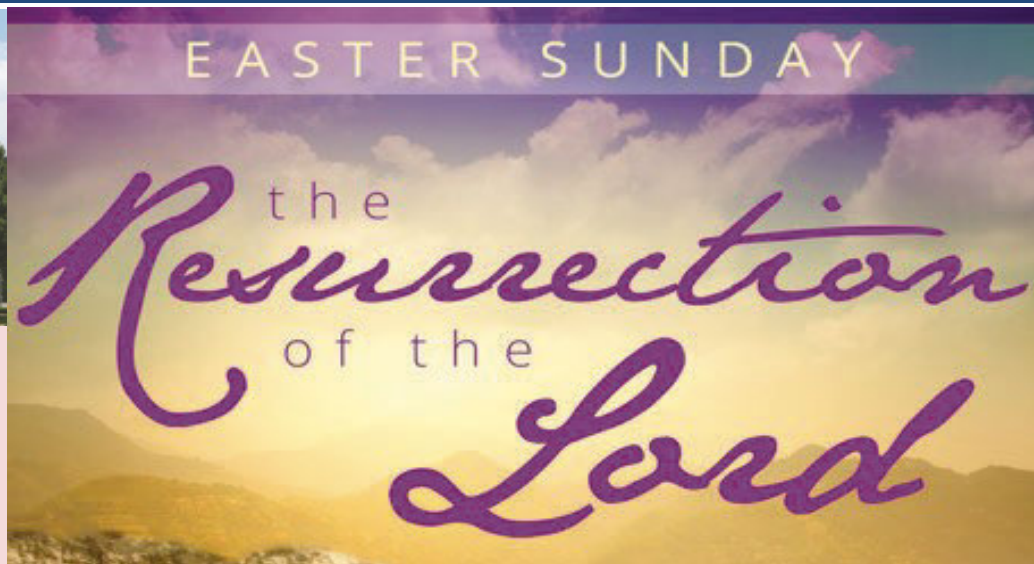

APRIL 20, 2025 RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

The Lord is Risen. He is Risen Indeed. Alleluia!

Easter Blessings to all and let us rejoice. The Resurrection of our Savior Jesus Christ heralds our birth to eternal life. As Jesus rises from the dead, so we too are offered the promise of life with Him for eternity. Death has been conquered. The wages of sin have been redeemed and glory fills the community. We sing Alleluia because we have no greater song of joy.

This feast we call "Easter" has a variety of names to emphasize this oldest and most significant Christian celebration. Referred to as the "Feast of feasts" and the "Solemnity of solemnities," St. Athanasius called it "the Great Sunday" to recognize the resurrection of Jesus Christ. This is our Passover experience where Christ saves us from death through His Resurrection. In this, we honor His gift of salvation and anticipate our participation in glory. To further emphasize the dignity of this feast, one day is not enough. Every day of the Octave (eight days) is celebrated as Easter, with the Gloria prayed each day at Mass. In addition, the Easter Season continues for 50 days to remind us we are an Easter people, always called to new life in Christ.

If you are a regular participant at our Sunday worship or joining us for Easter, please know that you are most welcome to our worshipping community. If you have been away for some time and would like to renew your familiarity with the parish, please contact Fr. Molini or Fr. Lawson who would be happy to sit down and talk with you. 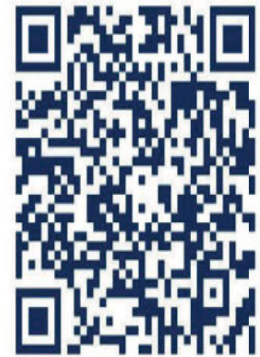

There will be a Closing Mass on Sunday, April 27, at Noon at St. Raphael Church and all are welcome to attend. We hope you can join us!

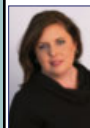
