Fr. Molini's Notes

Advent..."I am not worthy"

This Sunday's Gospel sharpens our understanding of John's ministry as one calling people to repentance and conversion. He firmly grasped his vocation in this prophetic role and, even when challenged by religious figures of the time, he neither diminished nor exalted his role. He realized his place in God's plan for salvation and embraced it, recognizing his value as called by God, but he was not the fulfillment of the promise. Crowds of peoples flocked to hear him and receive his baptism. He was the talk of the town. Disciples were forming about him. And in full humility he knew it was not about him but another. "I am not worthy to untie his sandal strap," a duty relegated to the lowest servant in a home. Advent directs our attention to Another, and, while urging us to claim our place in God's plan of salvation as a child of God, like John we are called to humility. Do we make room in our hearts and lives for Another, for Christ whose image may be found in the poor in need of food, the homeless needing a place to live, the ill needing assistance, the estranged family member needing forgiveness and understanding? Advent asks us to embrace the humility that looks beyond ourselves with faithful purpose. We each have a particular vocation in the plan of salvation, a vocation of dignity as a member of Christ's Body to share God's message of hope. We are also called to humbly hear that message first in our hearts and allow our hearts to be configured to the loving heart of Christ who is the Savior of us all. Lord, may I proclaim Your love with humility, so others listening to me may hear Your Word.

Christmas Novena

For years, St. Gabriel has celebrated the Christmas Novena, a traditional practice to prepare for the Solemnity of Christmas. Several evenings are dedicated to prayer, recalling the various prophecies about the coming of Christ. While customarily nine nights, our "Novena" will begin on December 17, and continue through December 23. Please join us for this traditional Christmas preparation. On the weekends we will begin after the evening Mass; during the week, we will begin at 7:00pm.

Let's take a few minutes to contemplate those last nine words. What if we choose to treat those less fortunate as if we are not worthy to untie their sandal straps? Let's lift them up with our prayers and generous gifts. Ask the Lord to give us direction, understanding, patience, strength, and most of all, a great portion of love to pour onto those suffering individuals. During this time of Advent, we ask Our Lord Jesus Christ to help us find the way.

This weekend's Sacred Scripture readings:
Ritual Song: No. 1097
Pray Together: Page 31

"Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." — 1 Thessalonians 5:16 - 18

This scripture reading sums up Stewardship. "Rejoice always" means to place our trust in God; He will provide all that we need. "Pray constantly" means to shape a running conversation with God throughout the whole day, every day. "Give thanks in all circumstances" means, even in bad situations, to thank God. Suffering a little bit helps build empathy for others in similar situations and shows our dependence on God.
