Fr. Molini's Notes

Fourth Sunday of Advent

Our Gospel this Sunday shares with us the beauty of seeing God in the relationships of our lives. Mary and Elizabeth share a remarkable moment of faith and joy as they are both able to see the hand of God in their lives, and respond to each other in the Holy Spirit. This Visitation moment is lifted up for us in the Advent season to call us to recognize the work of God in the relationships of our lives. Have I made myself open to God's work in my own life, allowing the Holy Spirit to call me into repentance, self-giving, and charity toward others? How do I extend to others the generosity that God has shown to me in giving me life, family, friends, and a faith community? Do I prayerfully consider the movement of God's will in my life and gratefully recognize it in the lives of others?

The Advent season calls us to celebrate relationships, first and foremost, the relationship established by Jesus taking flesh in the Incarnation. His act of love radiates throughout creation, redeeming us to God. This act of sacrifice is our call to self-sacrifice and generosity to others in the image of Jesus Christ whose birth we celebrate. Mary's visit to Elizabeth brings Christ to another, and Elizabeth responds in praise and gratitude. May we recognize Christ in others, responding in praise and gratitude to God.

Infant Baptism


