Dear SRA Friends,

I am grateful to announce that the 2024 St. Raphael the Archangel Black & Gold Dinner Auction will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2024! At this time last year, we all felt some degree of anxiety about the future of our parish with “All Things New.” Even with that level of uncertainty, we still had an incredibly successful auction that spoke volumes about the spirit of our community and how #SRAStrong we are! Recently, the SRA community was blessed with news that there are no planned changes to the structure of our parish. And so, without the apprehension that accompanied last year’s auction, we are moving forward to make this year’s event even more successful!

The Auction committee and Father Molini considered the direction of the 2024 Fund-A-Need, which comprises a substantial portion of the proceeds raised by the auction, and I am excited to announce the plans for the 2024 Fund-A-Need:

- Fund-A-Need will address safety, security, and cosmetic improvements to the interior and exterior of the school.**
- Specifically, we will replace the exterior Jamieson-side gym entrance (E) doors and the exterior cafeteria entrance (C) doors with more secure ones, designed to better match the main school entrance doors.**
- Additionally, the gym will be updated to better represent our parish. Updates will include the replacement of the damaged stage curtain with one in compliance with fire safety standards, and the replacement of damaged team chairs.**
- Funds raised above and beyond these needs will be reserved for a future project to build a new recess play area and make improvements to the parking lot.**
