#### New Year's Day – what about Mass?

Years ago, the American bishops decided that, due to the challenges some priests faced in providing Masses in areas that required large distances traveled, they would drop the "obligation" to attend Mass on some holy days when they fell on a Monday or Saturday. That's the case we have this year with New Year's Day, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. While it is still a holy day, the obligation to attend Mass is suspended. We will, however, celebrate Masses that day following our regular weekday schedule: 6:00am Mass at St. Gabriel and 8:00am Mass at both St. Raphael and St. Gabriel.
