Fr. Molini's Notes

Ash Wednesday and Lent

This week we open the season of Lent with the somber celebration of Ash Wednesday. Invited to wear ashes, we witness to each other the importance of prayer, penance, and almsgiving. All are invited to participate in Holy Mass this day.

Ashes are ordinarily distributed only during Mass following the homily.

St. Raphael Masses are at 8:00am and 7:00pm.

St. Gabriel Masses are at 6:00am, 8:00am, 12 noon, and 6:00pm.

Lent also brings a variety of opportunities for prayer and fellowship.

As mentioned last week, parishioners of both parishes are invited to join in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Gabriel on all Tuesdays of Lent after the 8:00am Mass until 9:00pm when we will conclude with Benediction.

Stations of the Cross are held Wednesdays at St. Gabriel at 7:00pm, beginning February 28. (I was unaware of this practice and scheduled the Mass for February 21.)

Stations of the Cross are held on Fridays of Lent at St. Raphael at 12 noon.

Our regular daily and Saturday schedule of confessions remains the same and offers opportunities to make a good confession during this season.

Eucharistic Adoration

Parishioners of both parishes are invited to spend time in reflective prayer before the Blessed Sacrament exposed on Tuesdays of Lent. Each Tuesday following the 8:00am Mass, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament at St. Gabriel until Benediction at 9:00pm. This will allow members of both parishes to spend some time before the blessed Sacrament in prayer and show a common effort of adoration in the St. Louis Hills area.

Additionally, it will offer the opportunity for other groups to come and join in prayer on Tuesdays. We can try this during the Lenten season and, if successful, extend it throughout the year. I'm asking for volunteers to sign up for the hours of 9:00am until 9:00pmon Tuesdays for Eucharistic adoration.

This will also allow devotions that currently exist on Tuesdays to continue, such as the Perpetual Help devotions at 6:45 and the Divine Mercy at 9:00pm. It offers opportunities for groups to schedule time of prayer and reflection together, perhaps an evening of prayer for organizations during Lent. While the majority of time should be silent, vocal prayer and reflections may be included when organized in advance.

If you would like to join this effort to celebrate the Eucharistic Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, go to the parish website for more information.

A Flocknote will be sent out for an easier way to link to the sign-up.

We will also continue the "First Friday" Exposition at St. Raphael each month. There, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed after the 8:00am Mass and Benediction begins at 2:00pm. All are of course welcome to join us then as well.
