Fr. Molini's Notes

First Sunday of Lent

The readings today call us to renewal, particularly as we enter the fullness of the Lenten season. After the destruction and anxiety of the flood, we see Noah and his family leaving the ark into a new world, given with a renewed covenant from God. Purified by their experience, they enter forth into a new life. In our Baptismal liturgy, during the blessing of the water, we recall the cleansing effects of the flood. Praying over the water, we say, "The waters of the great flood you made a sign of the waters of Baptism that make an end of sin and a new beginning of goodness."

In our Gospel, Jesus enters into His ministry having spent time in the desert, galvanizing His understanding of His Father's will, to proclaim God's Kingdom.

By our Baptism, we all are joined to the ministry of Jesus Christ, to proclaim God's Kingdom through our words and actions, evangelizing by our lives. This Lenten season is often seen as a period of greater reflection and consideration of this ministry. Using the pillars of the season, Prayer, Penance, and Almsgiving, how do we strengthen our commitment to the Gospel mandate to "...go out to all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them everything I have commanded you..."?

Consider, if at any point in the day, have we spoken about God's action in our lives? Have we spoken to a prayer answered, a grace received, even the gratitude for being given another day? Evangelization can be the simple act of sharing how God has touched us today, in our lives, or by the witness of another. Our call to discipleship is manifested in small ways each day as we recognize God's presence, and see the opportunity for new expressions of gratitude and ministry.

To further address our call to discipleship, Archbishop Rozanski has shared his thoughts with us in a small book available at the doors of the church. Please take one and use it as a reflection for the season.

Holy Week

It's never too early to plan our participation in the events of Holy Week. Here is the schedule for each parish. Holy Thursday (March 28) Mass of the Lord's Supper

- St. Raphael 7:00pm with the church remaining open for prayer until 10:00pm
- St. Gabriel 7:00pm with the church remaining open for prayer until 11:00pm

Good Friday (March 29) The Passion of Our Lord

- St. Raphael 7:00pm
- St. Gabriel 3:00pm

Holy Saturday (March 30) The Easter Vigil

Only one celebration of the Vigil at St. Gabriel - 8:00pm

(After speaking to the musicians at both parishes and the team working with those preparing to enter the Church at the Easter Vigil, it was decided one celebration would help emphasize the significance of the Vigil in the life of the Church.)

Lent also brings a variety of opportunities for prayer and fellowship.

Parishioners of both parishes are invited to join in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at St. Gabriel on all Tuesdays of Lent after the 8:00am Mass until 9:00pm, when we will conclude with Benediction.

Stations of the Cross are held Wednesdays at St. Gabriel at 7:00pm, beginning February 28. (I was unaware of this practice and scheduled the Bishop DuBourg Ring Mass for February 21.)

Stations of the Cross are held on Fridays of Lent at St. Raphael at 12 noon.
