Fr. Molini's Notes

Eucharistic Adoration

For some time the idea of more opportunity for Eucharistic adoration has been rattling around in my head. While both parishes have a short time each month, a more extended period of time seems appropriate as a way to offer opportunities for prayer, reflection, and focus on the Blessed Sacrament. Parishioners at both parishes have expressed similar desires. I would like to propose a trial of extended Eucharistic Adoration. Beginning in Lent, every Tuesday following the 8:00am Mass, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament at St. Gabriel until Benediction at 9:00pm. This would allow members of both parishes to make an opportunity to spend some time before the blessed Sacrament in prayer and show a common effort of adoration in the St. Louis Hills area.

Between both parishes, hopefully there are enough people to staff the hours. Additionally, it will offer the opportunity for other groups to come and join in prayer on Tuesdays. We can try this during the Lenten season and, if successful, extend it throughout the year. I'm asking for volunteers to sign up for the hours of 9:00am until 9:00pm on Tuesdays for Eucharistic adoration.

This schedule will also allow devotions that currently exist on Tuesdays to continue, such as the Perpetual Help devotions at 6:45pm and the Divine Mercy at 9:00pm. In addition, it offers opportunities for groups to schedule time of prayer and reflection, perhaps an evening of prayer for organizations during Lent. While the majority of time should be silent, vocal prayer and reflections may be included when organized in advance. We will also continue the "First Friday" Exposition at St. Raphael each month. There, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed after the 8:00am Mass and Benediction begins at 2:00pm. All are of course welcome to join us then as well.

Ash Wednesday is February 14 this year. You may wish to make your Valentine's Day plans for another day since Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence.
