

Fr. Molini's Notes

What's so Ordinary?

While the Church lists this Sunday and the following several weeks as "Ordinary Time," it surely feels extraordinary. We have the challenges of weather as winter makes its presence felt. Catholic Schools Week at the end of the month allows us to celebrate the valuable ministry of Catholic Education. February 2 is the Feast of the Presentation that recalls the Holy Family bringing Jesus to the temple and marking the feast by blessing candles to honor Him as the Light of Light. It is carnival season, celebrating the time before the somber season of Lent with the frivolous elements of Mardi Gras. Where is the ordinary?

The green vestments of Mass are used to focus our attention on the virtue of Hope, the ordinary disposition of a child of God. We live our lives in the hope of eternal life that ideally influences our ordinary activities and relationships. We hope to be signs of God's love to others by expressing our Faith in action. We face the common challenges of life with confidence, knowing that God has sent His Son as our Savior, calling us to union with His Divine Love.
