Fr. Molini's Notes

When I referenced the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, Corpus Christi, in my homily last weekend, I mentioned that Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi Sunday homilies could easily get caught up in a doctrinal testament to the teachings of these truths. The real gift with both feasts, however, is the call to a relationship with God, in the community of the Trinity and particularly with Jesus our Brother. Today's celebration of the Body and Blood of Jesus calls us to a deeper intimacy in this love. The gift is given by Christ to His Church as a call to become what it is we eat...to BE Jesus.

Currently, there are four groups of pilgrims processing throughout the United States, moving to the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis later this summer. As they move, they are calling us to a deeper devotion to the Eucharistic Presence of Jesus Christ. The pilgrims will be visiting the St. Louis area from July 5 to July 7, stopping at a number of churches for prayer. The churches include: St. Charles Borromeo, St. Peter, and the Shrine of St. Rose Philippine Duschesne, all in St. Charles, on July 5. On July 6, the Missionaries of Charity campus and St. Matthew Church. On July 7, the Cathedral Basilica and St. Stephen Protomartyr Church. More details will follow in *The Review*. Please join in one of these historic events – the first national Eucharistic Procession in our history.

Missionary Speaker, June 8 and 9

In conjunction with the Archdiocesan Missionary Plan of Cooperation, we welcome Sr. Pelagia Karengi with the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary-Tabora (CDMT) Tanzania, East Africa. Sister Pelagia will speak at all Masses on the weekend of June 8 and 9. Envelopes for donations will be available in the pews. The Congregation of the Daughters of Mary, headquartered in the Archdiocese of Tabora, was founded in 1933. It was established in response to the tremendous social, economic, and spiritual needs of the local people. The Community members live their Charisma of love and service through different ministries, such as health care, pastoral ministry, social works, education, and women and youth development. Education and healthcare services are particularly directed to rural areas where the members serve nomadic people, orphans, and deaf children.

Mass Intentions

A centuries-old practice in the Catholic Church, offering Mass for a specific intention, heightens the awareness of praying for others. While every Mass is offered for the good of the Church in praise of the Father through the Sacrifice of Jesus Christ, the custom of asking for a particular remembrance during each Mass allows us to support each other in prayer. The practice of making an offering for the intention also unites the sacrifice of the faithful to the sacrifice of Christ. While the "stipend" is not required for a Mass, it is customarily made as a gift to the priest celebrating the Mass. Masses offered for the deceased for the repose of their souls will have their names mentioned in the bulletin. A Mass for the living is usually shown simply as a "special intention" for privacy purposes; however, the person's name can be included, if so desired.

During this summer there will be two seminarians living at St. Gabriel, and you may see them at Masses at both parishes. Zach Stehr and Adam Barger are both studying for the Archdiocese of St. Louis. During the week, Zach will be assisting the Pastoral Care team at Mercy Hospital, and Adam will be helping at the Vocation Office and Youth Ministry Office of the Diocese.
