The Pharisees went off and plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech. They sent their disciples to him, with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that you are a truthful man and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth. And you are not concerned with anyone's opinion, for you do not regard a person's status. Tell us, then, what is your opinion: Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?" Knowing their malice, Jesus said, "Why are you testing me, you hypocrites? Show me the coin that pays the census tax." Then they handed him the Roman coin. He said to them, "Whose image is this and whose inscription?" They replied, "Caesar's." At that he said to them, "Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."

#### Fr. Molini's Notes

### **Pilgrimage**

Again, please remember that I will be away from the parish from October 23 to November 10. I will certainly carry your intentions with me as we visit the various shrines of the Blessed Mother and other religious sites. Please pray for our safe travels and return.

#### **Schools**

Due to the recent announcement about some Catholic schools facing conversations about their stability and status, some parents have asked about the schools at our parishes. Neither St. Gabriel nor St. Raphael schools are included in these conversations. As I have repeated, I was assigned to pastor two parishes with two schools and two autonomous programs. For our parishes, I believe the conversation is more about the ongoing effectiveness of our programs to impart the Catholic Faith to our children and families. "The Catholic school forms part of the saving mission of the Church, especially for education in the faith. Remembering that the simultaneous development of man's psychological and moral consciousness is demanded by Christ almost as a pre-condition for the reception of the befitting divine gifts of truth and grace, the Church fulfills her obligation to foster in her children a full awareness of their rebirth to a new life. It is precisely in the Gospel of Christ, taking root in the minds and lives of the faithful, that the Catholic school finds its definition as it comes to terms with the cultural conditions of the times." (Paragraph 9, "The Catholic School" by the Sacred Congregation for Catholic Education, 1977) As we continue to work at improving our educational programs, the priority of evangelization is paramount to all these conversations.

### **All Saints Day**

While much attention is given to Halloween as indicated by the decorations on many homes, let's all remember the reason for Halloween is the Feast of All Saints on November 1, called in some countries "All Hallows." All Hallows Eve should remind us of the importance of celebrating our call to be saints...and, as such, preparing us now to join all the saints in the heavenly kingdom. Celebrating at Mass is our way, even now, of anticipating that experience of the Kingdom: God's people gathered around the altar participating in the Sacrifice of Christ. Don't forget to include a visit to God's House as part of the celebration.
